

Grant details and acknowledgments are not permitted as numbered references, and footnotes should not be used.

ICBE 2019 Conference uses standard nature referencing style. All authors' names should be included in reference lists with the last name first, followed by a comma and initials (followed by full stops) of given names. Article titles should be in Roman text, only the first letter of the title should be capitalized and the title should be written exactly as it appears in the work cited, ending with a full stop. Book titles should be given in italics and all words in the title should be capitalized. Journal names are italicized and abbreviated (with full stops) according to common usage. Volume numbers and the subsequent comma appear in bold. The range of the full page should be given appropriately. Reference in text are rendered in several ways. For example:
